NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 1400, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77056, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Wednesday, November 3, 2021, at 1:00 p.m.

The Board shall consider and/or act on the following matters:

1. Comments from the public;
2. Review and approve the minutes of the October 6, 2021, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Review activity reports and/or receive updates regarding Fort Bend County Precinct 3 Constable's Office ("FBCCO");
4. Consider approval of Agreement for Additional Law Enforcement Services Between Fort Bend County and Seven Meadows Community Association, Inc.;
5. Status of conversion to LED bulbs and painting of the decorative light poles in the community by CenterPoint Energy;
6. Status of proposal for wildflower seeding of certain recreational sites within the District;
7. Tax Assessor-Collector Report, including status of delinquent tax accounts, authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds and moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
8. Delinquent Tax Collections Attorney Report, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements and the filing of proofs of claim;
9. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial investment reports, authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
10. Status of compliance by the District with Texas Government Code, Chapter 2265, relative to energy reporting and authorize any action in connection therewith;

 - (i) Installation of an emergency generator at the District's remote water well;



 - (ii) Repair of approximate of North Outfall Channel Detention Pond utilizing the SOX erosion repair system;
 - b. Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any pay estimates, change orders and/or acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, including:
 - (i) Repair of approximate 300-foot portion of Little Prong Creek at Fry Road utilizing the SOX erosion repair system and repair of outfall (Double Oak Erosion); and
 - c. Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District;
- 12. Report by Champions Hydro-Lawn, Inc., regarding maintenance of drainage facilities;
- 13. Storm Water Management Program for the District;
- 14. Operations and Maintenance Report, including:
 - a. Authorizing the repair and maintenance of District facilities;

- 18. Authorize attorney to file Eminent Domain Report with the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts prior to February 1, 2022, pursuant to Section 2206.154, Texas Government Code;

20. Discuss status of the District's compliance with America's Water Infrastructure Act of 2018, including approval of Emergency Response Plan and authorize submission of the Certificate of Completion related to same;

Convene in Closed Session pursuant to Open Meetings Act, Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, for consultation with the District's attorney regarding pending or threatened litigation or matters protected by attorney-client privilege and/or Sections 551.076 and 551.089, Texas Government Code, to discuss Emergency Response Plan related to District security;
22. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize any action resulting from discussions in Closed Session; and
23. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
